KPS BAND FEES AND INSTRUMENT HIRE

All students who are members of the Junior and Concert Bands are required to pay band fees and instrument hire where applicable. Payments can be made yearly or by four equal term instalments.

The payment is separate from the Riverina Conservatorium of Music tuition fee.

Fees for band and instrument hire must be paid in full by the due date as stated on the invoice.

Failure to make these payments will result in the student not being able to attend morning band rehearsals until the payment is received.

A student must be financial to attend performances outside of the school.

To attend a performance a student must also have attended no less that 4 out of 5 morning band rehearsal session immediately leading up to a performance (both inside and outside of the school). This is with the exception of sickness or extenuating circumstances

Should your child wish to cease playing in the band, you will be required to inform the Friends of the Band Committee in writing. Fees and instrument hire will continue to be charged until such time as notice has been received.

Instruments will be immediately returned should a student no longer wish to be a member of the band, or hire fees will still be charged.
