Policy Agreement

This document outlines the conditions for application and selection for a bursary subsidy for the school component of the KPS band program.

An RCM bursary for tutorials will be determined in consultation with the RCM and Principal. Successful applicants will then be able to apply for the school component of the bursary.

Families wishing to apply for the bursary must complete this application and final approval will be granted by the discretion Principal and school Band Liaison. A maximum of 2 students will be covered by this bursary per year.

Bursary Entitlement

Includes:

- Half of the KPS Band Program fees
- Half of the school instrument hire (if applicable)
- No fundraising fee

Conditions:

- Student must maintain a minimum of 80% attendance at band rehearsals and lessons
- Instrument care is maintained, and any damages are payable by the family
- Family to attend a minimum of 1 band event per term (includes meetings, events as a helper or fundraising events)
